1	Voucher Order ID	Unique identifier for the voucher order.
2	Voucher Code	Code assigned to exam voucher.
3	Funding Source	School or district that ordered vouchers or N/A if not funded by school or district.
4	First Name	Student's first name.
5	Nickname (previously Preferred Name)	Student's nickname, if provided.
6	Middle Initial	Student's middle initial, if provided.
7	Last Name	Student's last name.
8	Date of Birth	Student's date of birth (MM/DD/YYYY)
9	Gender	Male, Female, or Not Specified (previously Male, Female, or Another)
10	Ethnicity	Student's self-reported ethnicity (if provided). See table below.
11	Race	Student's self-reported race (if provided). See table below.
12	High School	Full name of the student's high school.
13	AI Code	College Board's assigned AI (Attending Institution) code for the high school.
14	Registration ID	Unique exam registration identifier
15	Exam Date	Date the CLEP exam was taken (MM/DD/YYYY)
16	Test Location	Test center code where exam was taken
17	Exam Subject	Name of the CLEP exam subject taken by the student.
18	Score	CLEP scaled score, 20-80
